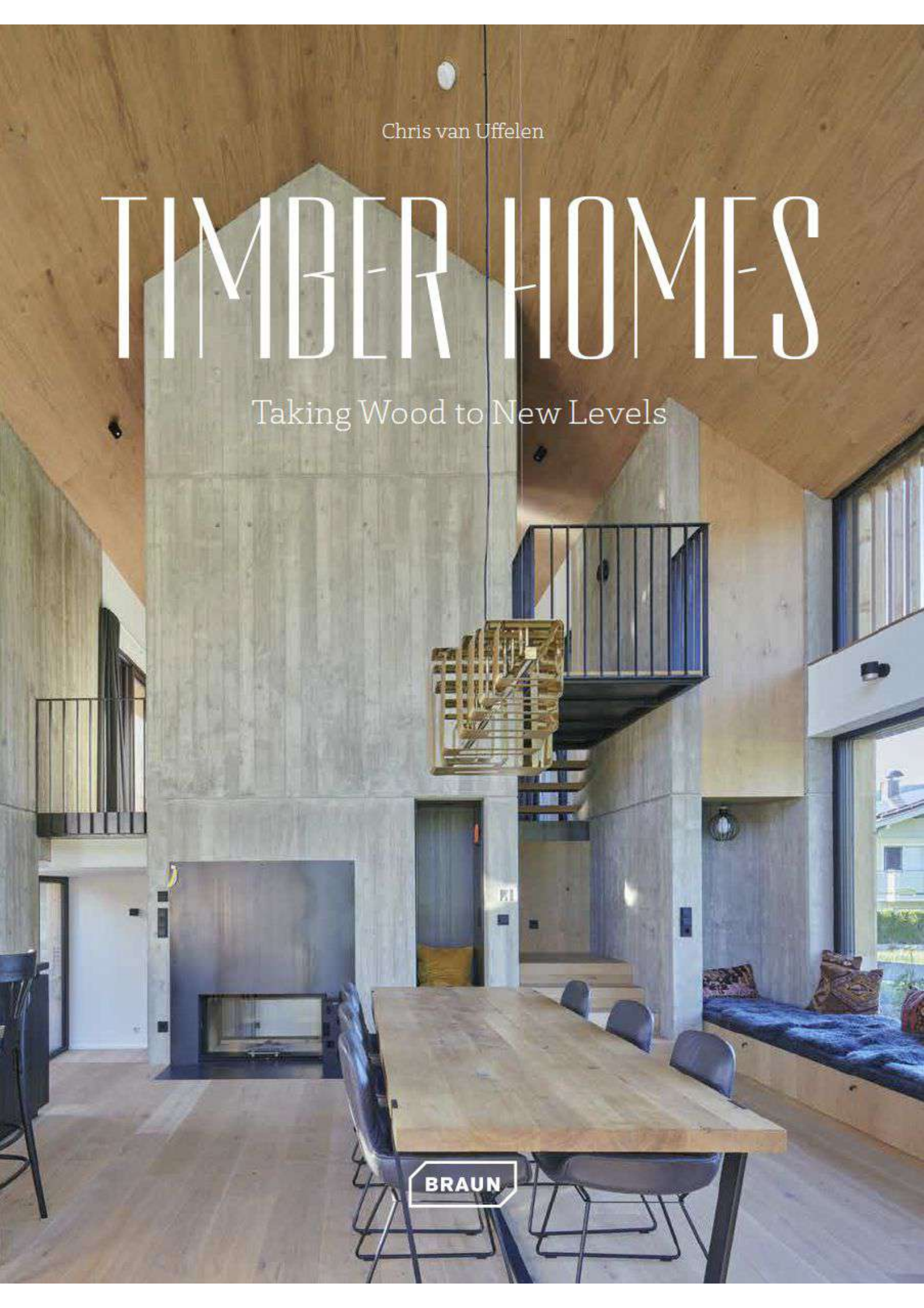

Guest houses 3.0 are the new type of hotel rooms in the hotel and recreational complex Verholy Relax Park. Having a cozy patio allows the guests even more privacy along with nature. Only the forest, the noise of trees, the singing of birds and nobody else on the horizon.

This new type of guest house is maximally integrated into the surrounding pine forest thanks to the patio and the increased area of fully panoramic glazing. The houses are built from lightweight metal frame structures, made in accordance with the designers' drafts. Instead of the usual solid base, the house stands on a so-called screw base. This technology allows setting the structure quickly in any landscape – in this case among the pines without damaging any trees or their root system. So these houses are standing at least a meter above the ground.

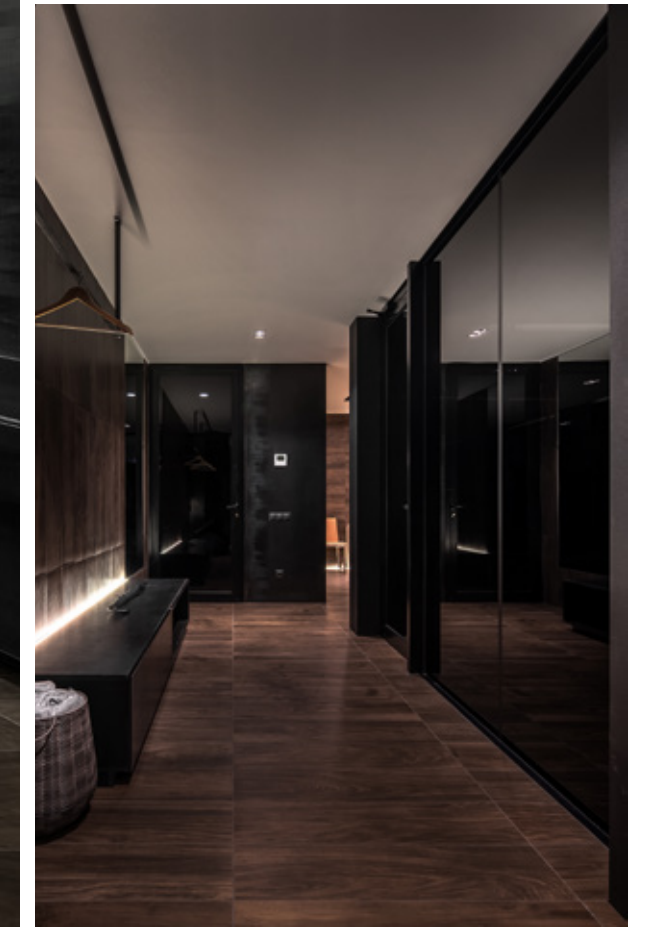

Wood: heat-treated alder for façades, veneered oak plywood used for walls, larch plates used for ceilings and terrace





From outside buildings are covered with heat-treated plates made of solid alder. The interior floors are tiled and equipped with water heating; the walls are covered with plywood from veneered oak, ceilings and terrace - with larch plates. For finishing the architects used natural materials and natural color gamma.



Dark wood dominates the interior, making lights even more effective.
